## DeSales University Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress

In order to retain eligibility for federal and institutional financial aid, students must maintain satisfactory progress in their academic program, and they must be in good academic standing. Students are required to complete 40-3 credit courses and are expected to average 5-3 credit courses per semester.

Satisfactory Academic Progress is reviewed at the end of each semester for traditional day and ACCESS students. Students are not considered to be maintaining satisfactory academic progress for financial aid when their academic progress fails to meet the following qualitative and quantitative requirements:

Any additional students who are placed on Academic Probation because of failure to meet the institution's Academic Standards based on a combination of attempted credits AND attempted courses will also be deemed no to be making academic progress for financial aid.

The completion rate is calculated as the number of passed courses (courses for which a student earned a passing grade) divided by the number of attempted courses (the total of earned courses, and courses for which a student has received a grad
